Organizations that are eligible to submit proposals

- Institutions of Higher Education
 - Two- and four-year IHEs
 - IHEs located outside the United States
- Non-profit, Non-academic Organizations
 - Independent museums, observatories, research laboratories, professional societies, and similar organizations
- Tribal Nations





NSF Policy – Eligibility



Organizations that may be eligible to submit proposals

- For-profit Organizations
 - U.S.-based commercial organizations, including small businesses, with strong capabilities in scientific or engineering research or education and a passion for innovation.
- State and Local Governments
 - As programmatically necessary and identified in a program solicitation
- Foreign Organizations
 - NSF rarely provides direct funding support to foreign organizations
- Other Federal Agencies

NSF does not normally support research or education activities by scientists, engineers or educators employed by Federal agencies or FFRDCs.



NSF Policy – Eligibility



Unaffiliated Individuals

- Unaffiliated individuals are <u>not eligible</u> to receive direct funding from NSF
- Individuals submitting a proposal to an NSF Postdoctoral Fellowship program solicitation are not considered unaffiliated individuals.










- Limits on Organizational Eligibility
 - Restricted to a specific type(s) of organization
- Limits on PI Eligibility
 - May restrict to type of degree or disciplinary research area, tenure status, etc.
- Limits on Number of Proposals Submitted per Organization
 - Restricts total number of proposals per organization per competition
- Limits on Number of Proposals Submitted per PI
 - May restrict to number of proposals or subawards that a PI or co-PI may be associated with, number of proposals in a specified date range, or total number of submissions over a PI or co-PI's career
- Other Solicitation-Specific Eligibility Criteria





- Grant Opportunities for Academic Liaison with Industry (GOALI)
 - Organizational and PI eligibility
- Facilitation Awards for Scientists and Engineers with Disabilities (FASED)
 - PI and senior personnel eligibility persons with disabilities
- Career Life Balance (CLB) Supplemental Funding Requests
 - Research awards
 - Postdoctoral fellows
 - GRFP recipients
